

GREETINGS IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST!
Soar Valley Prayer Fellowship - Monday 10th June 2012

The meeting was held at Sutton Bonington Baptist Church, Pastor John Hebblethwaite opened the meeting with a reading from Zechariah ch 4, emphasising in verse 6 the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the Lord Almighty. The hymn 'O breath of life, come sweeping through us', was sung, as we placed the SOAR Valley and the evening in His hands.

BARROW ON SOAR ask us to join them as they seek the Lord's guidance regarding a second Pastor to work alongside Mark, as well as helping out at Long Wharton, Pray for the Jubilee Bibles given out, as well for a witness for the July 8th Olympics event in the village. They are presently running a Parenting Course, and hope to start a new series 'Beautiful Life' to encourage the Church and community.

CASTLE DONTNGTON Please pray for this small group as they are stepping out in faith, and have asked Gary Wood if he will be a part-time Pastor for them. On July the 1st he will be presenting a '2yr plan', to be followed on the 4th July by a Church meeting to make a decision. Pray that the Lord's will, will be made known for the future of this Church.

HATHERN as there was not a representative, the Oasis group was prayed for, as well as the continued support for the Sunday Evening service.

KEGWORTH again no representative, however the youth work was prayed for, as well as a Hindu family who are attending Church.

LONG WHATTON Praise the Lord for a good time at the Jubilee festival, they ask prayer for a weekend away for the fellowship, with the theme 'Belonging'. They have asked us to join in their prayer target for five new, 'baptised believers' for the coming year. Also pray that the 2 new teachers needed at the new school would be Christians.

LOUGHBOROUGH again no representative, but prayer was given for the 'Cafe' project of the adjoining Yorkshire Bank building, that all the practical issues involved in starting up would go smoothly.

MOUNTSORREL are praising the Lord for the Council's grant in providing 'ramps' for the disabled to enable them to use the back of the church more effectively. The prayer walks continue but would like to have 'encounters', to explain why. They are hoping to update the upstairs to be used for the Youth work, and are claiming Luke 10 v2, for more helpers. They are also asking God for 25 new christian/prodigals to come into the Church.

QUORN are planning a Holiday Club in August, and would like to see the contact with parents increased. A 'Christianity Explored' course is planned for later in the year, as is a service to give thanks for the completions of all the changes in the Sanctuary.

ROTHLEY have a wedding in two weeks, pray for God to bless the couple, who are new to the church. A Christianity Explored course is running with young couples please pray for fruit from this.

SHEPSHED have just come to the end of a Just 10 course, the study is being continued in house groups. They are initiating a new venture in Shepshed, FreeDA, as there are a substantial number of in debt in the village, 6 people are at the moment being trained for this, and a room is being prepared at the Church.

SUTTON BONINGTON need prayer and His guidance for the Diaconate, as they need a new Secretary and Treasurer. On June 24th they have one adult and 2 young folk being baptised, pray for friends and family who will be attending, as well as for the candidates, and that all in the Youth Group would be drawn to Him. There is a possibility of a house group forming from the 'Messy Church' pray that this may happen. On June 18th there is to be a 'Malgasy' choir singing at the local school.

WOODHOUSE EAVES as there was no representative we join them in praying for two new families to come to the Church.
